The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Broward County's cost of living has substantially increased with a 2.9% increase from just a year ago which is 14.9% higher than the national average. The largest increases were found in transportation, food, and housing meaning Broward County Residents need access to training for in demand jobs such as the many available in aviation locally and regionally now more than ever and many can not afford to leave home for training. Broward College and the expansion of the Aviation Training Center provides vital access to the latest technology and training right here in Broward County.
