I am requesting funding for Equipment Acquisition to advance functional precision medicine approaches and imaging studies for hard-to-treat cancers in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Florida International University (FIU), located at 11200 SW 8 Street, Miami, FL 33199.

The funding would be used for FIU to purchase equipment and imaging material for a precision medicine program that provides personalized and functional drug testing on individual patient's tumor cells to guide clinical decision making and provide novel therapeutic options for pediatric cancer patients with no alternative options.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because treatments for patients whose cancers have returned and have exhausted standard treatment options remain an unmet and major challenge across the country resulting in 600,000 deaths annually. FIU is well-positioned to be leading critical research and national clinical trials focused on approaches to identify individualized treatment options more rapidly for hard-to-treat cancers, in particular with minority populations.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by NIST's mission and aligned with one or more of the functions and activities described in section 272 of title 15, United States Code.
