Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the City of Miramar Pembroke Roads Expansion Project. The project will widen Pembroke Road from two to four lanes from SW 160 Avenue (Dykes Road) to SW 196 Avenue, constructing a new 2-lane roadway with median barrier wall, landscaping, irrigation, sidewalk, shared use path and lighting from SW 196 Avenue to US 27, and constructing a new 2-lane roadway with median, landscaping, irrigation, sidewalk, bike lanes and lighting along Miramar Parkway from SW 192 Terrace to Pembroke Road, just west of SW 196 Avenue. Construction of buffer walls is also planned adjacent to some residential areas (Silver Shores neighborhood on the south side of Pembroke Road just west of Dykes, and along Miramar Parkway behind Harbor Lakes). The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Miramar, located at 2300 Civic Center Place, Miramar, FL 33025. The funding would be used

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve safety, traffic flow, and connectivity for residents of Pembroke Pines and Miramar, including neighborhoods like Silver Shores and Harbor Lakes. It benefits commuters, pedestrians, cyclists, and emergency services by easing congestion, adding multi-use paths, and creating safer routes to schools, businesses, and residential areas in Southwest Broward County

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
